Applicant proposes its Service Area to include the following eleven (11) Counties in the State of Washington:

Columbia

Douglas

Franklin

Kittitas

Lincoln

Okanogan

Walla Walla

Yakima

Letters of support from each of the above eleven (11) Counties are attached as Joint Exhibit 1. In addition, we are attaching, as Joint Exhibit 2, letters of support from seven (7) of the Ports that are within the service area (Ports of Benton, Columbia, Douglas, Quincy, Royal Slope, Walla Walla and Warden) as well as from two (2) of the Cities that are within the Service Area (Quincy and Tonasket). A map depicting the Counties, outlined in green, that comprise the Service Area is attached as Exhibit 3. It is to be noted that nine (9) of the eleven (11) counties totally satisfy the adjacency requirement of the FTZ Board's Regulations (within 60 miles or 90 minutes' driving time from the limits of your CBP Port of Entry in Moses Lake, Washington). The two (2) Counties that partially satisfy the adjacency requirement of the FTZ Board's Regulations (Okanogan and Yakima) will have the following defined boundaries for purposes of being within the Service Area:

Okanogan County Service Area will include everything south of State Highway #20 from Mablemount to Omak and everything south of State Highway #155 from Omak to Nespelem continuing to the Okanagan County Line.

Yakima County Service Area will include everything north of State Highway #12 and east of Longitude 121 Degrees.

Attached, as Exhibit 4, is a map depicting the areas in both Okanogan County and Yakima County that are within the Service Area. The areas highlighted in blue in both counties are outside the Service Area.
